We are 200 employees, and we annually produce 25,000 tons of white cheese, primarily sold under the Apetina® brand.

You will be part of a fast-paced and exciting dairy environment with a high complexity in the production flow and seasonality - and where we continuously navigate between branded and private label products.

Challenging tasks and projects

You will be exposed to (and responsible for) a number of operational tasks such as milk intake and production planning, KPI tracking, inventory controlling and management, purchasing of packaging and ingredients etc. Furthermore, it is expected that you deliver on one or more projects within the following:

- Safety stock optimization
- Detailed mapping/description of the production planning process
- Visualization and optimization of the milk intake planning
- Development of an integrated planning model for the weekly planning
- Mapping and life cycle assessment of new materials

Student qualifications

You are studying logistics and planning on a Master degree level, e.g. supply chain or engineering, and ideally combined with experience from another position within logistics/planning. You are super user of the MS Office programmes – especially Excel.

If you have some knowledge within SAP R/3, it will be an advantage. On top of that, you have a systematic and analytical approach to your tasks.
