The project involves tasks such as summarizing, analyzing and systematizing information, data and stakeholder positions in

preparation for the meetings. Furthermore you will assist in arranging meetings and participate in them taking minutes and notes.

Student qualifications

A good understanding of the current sustainability debate is important and you should preferably have an interest and a background in sustainability or environmental science. An international outlook is also important, as Arla Foods' new sustainability strategy will be global in scope.

Being good at systematizing and synthesizing information are very important qualities for the success of the project, and good English skills are a prerequisite. Personal qualities suitable for the project involve being socially easy going and efficient.
